SCS at Sea

For the incoming Grade 6 Summer School will also be organized.



The SHS students can opt for regular Summer School at the SCS (8 am-3 pm) and prepare for the upcoming Academic Year by working on weaker subjects, learning how to plan, what to expect etc. In the afternoon they will be able to choose between working with Marco Volcy, Snorkeling and Hiking, and an ART project.

The other option is to board Schooner Ruth for a 7 day voyage around the Caribbean Sea from Sunday July 7—Saturday July 13.

During this 6 day voyage, students will deal with real issues such as monitoring water consumption from a shared source. They will also take part in ship "watches" as part of the mariner crew and will participate in scrubbing, cleaning, and sharing the duties on board. Students develop life skills such as leadership, resilience, grit, accountability, and team work, characteristics that will lead them to success at both school/university and in life. They overcome challenges on a daily basis that strengthen both their character and confidence.

In the week of July 14, SCS Students are eligible for the voyage. Registration is mandatory.
